



- Children ages 12 & under get free admission when accompanied by an adult and must be reserved in advance at the time of Adult/Senior purchase. Limit of two free children's tickets per Adult/Senior ticket holder.
- ALL SALES ARE FINAL Ticket sales close one hour before the end of each session and only those with valid tickets will be admitted after that time.
- Only service animals are allowed onsite no pets.
- Bring your own lawn chair for seating in the concert area, but please note the areas designated for low-rise lawn chairs, standing, and dancing.
- We prefer Visa/MasterCard/Debit for Festival admission and drink tickets. Payment methods within the site vary according to each vendor, though there is no ATM on site.
- Alcohol may not be brought on site, and security may inspect bags upon entry. Please do feel free to bring a picnic lunch and any nonalcoholic beverages.
- Upon arrival at the festival site, we encourage you to take note of the
  applicable exits and First Aid locations. Please be advised that in the
